

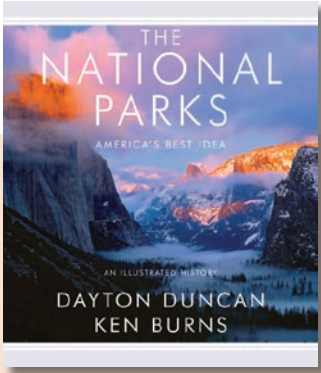
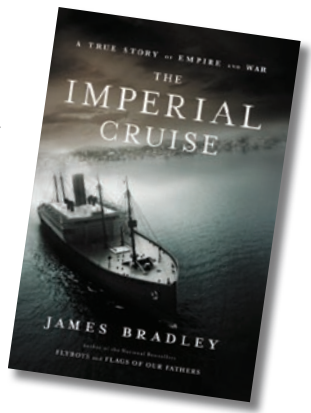


The Imperial Cruise: A True Story of Empire and War
