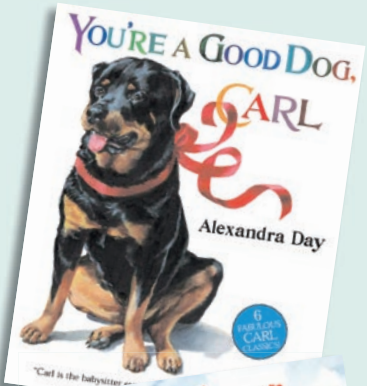

Alexandra Day Lifetime Achievement Award

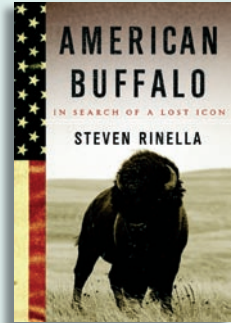

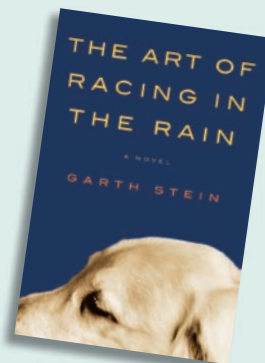


The Art of Racing in the Rain
