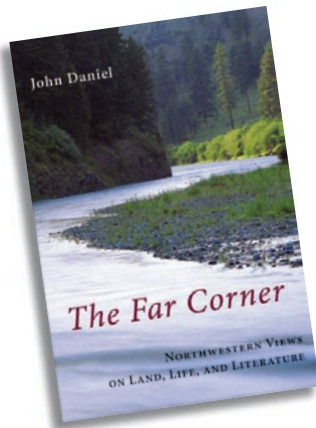

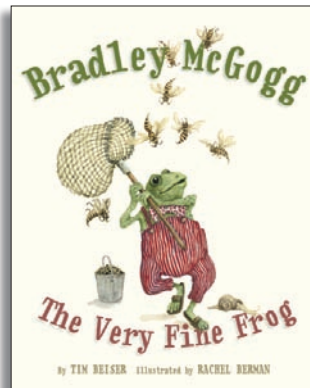


Bradley McGogg, The Very Fine Frog

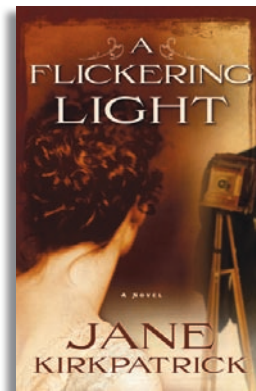


A Flickering Light
